A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

Councilmember Jack Evans introduced the following bill, which was referred to the
Committee on _____.

To repeal the National Capital Revitalization Corporation Act of 1998, and the
Anacostia Waterfront Corporation Act of 2004 to dissolve the National Capital
Revitalization Corporation and the Anacostia Waterfront Corporation and to transfer all
assets owned and functions performed by each entity to the Mayor.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
act may be cited as the “NCRC and AWC Reorganization Act of 2007”.

Sec. 2. The National Capital Revitalization Corporation Act of 1998, effective September
11, 1998 (D.C. Law 12-144; D.C. Official Code §2-1219.01 *et seq.*), is repealed.

Sec. 3. NCRC transition.

Pursuant to section 2:

(1) Title to the real property of the National Capital Revitalization Corporation, the
Redevelopment Land Agency (RLA) Revitalization Corporation, and any of their subsidiaries
shall vest, and be titled, in the name of the District.

(2) Subject to any obligations of the National Capital Revitalization Corporation, the
RLA Revitalization Corporation, and any subsidiary, all positions, personnel, property, records,
and unexpended balances of appropriations, allocations, and other funds available are transferred
to the Mayor.

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Sec. 4. The Anacostia Waterfront Corporation Act of 2004, effective December 7, 2004 (D.C. Law 15-219; D.C. Official Code § 2-1223.01 *et seq.*), is repealed.

Sec. 5. AWC transition.

Pursuant to section 4 and section 132 of the Anacostia Waterfront Corporation Act of 2004, effective December 7, 2004 (D.C. Law 15-219; D.C. Official Code § 2-1223.01 *et seq.*):

(1) Title to the real property of the Anacostia Waterfront Corporation and any of its subsidiaries shall vest, and be titled, in the name of the District.

(2) Subject to any obligations of the Anacostia Waterfront Corporation, all positions, personnel, property, records, and unexpended balances of appropriations, allocations, and other fund available to the Anacostia Waterfront Corporation and any subsidiary shall transfer to the Mayor.

Sec. 6. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement contained in the committee report as the fiscal impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(3)).

Sec. 7. Effective date.

This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of Congressional review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of Columbia Register.
